understand that the vet who is issuing the health certificate is giving an exam to make sure my cat does not have anything contagious AT THE TIME OF THE EXAM . If the cat you are adopting has FIV, they will be issued an FIV waiver. This consists of the same exam procedures, however FIV is considered contagious; therefore, the cat will be issued the waiver.
understand that my newly adopted cat may develop a kitty cold (otherwise known as the herpes virus) after bringing my cat home. All cats have the herpes virus; however, many do not exhibit any signs or symptoms until they are stressed. Going to a new home and adjusting to a new environment can be stressful for some cats. I understand that my newly adopted cat can potentially give his/her kitty cold, if one develops, to any of the current household cats. Also, any of my current cats can give it to my newly adopted cat. Symptoms of a kitty cold are similar to a human common cold. (sneezing, clear, runny eyes, discharge) If your cat has any discharge, a fever, becomes lethargic, isn't eating, or any other abnormal behaviors/symptoms, your cat MUST see a vet Will you bring your cat to the vet?
understand it is required to take my newly adopted cat to my vet two weeks post adoption
have confirmed my vet is able to see my cat in two weeks and is taking new clients
understand that ringworm has a 7-21 day incubation time. I understand that a cat can be carrier and break out with it. I understand ringworm is contagious to me and other pets in the household, and that if a human in the home in contact with the cat(s) has a fungus (athlete's foot, dandruff or ringworm) that it IS transmittable to the animals and could cause the animal to breakout with ringworm
If adopting a kitten; I understand that it is a baby with an underdeveloped immune system. Kittens are especially susceptible to catching viruses, bacteria, fungus, and parasites. I have allocated funds to properly care for my kittens as their first year of life may require several vet visits, or even emergency care. I am prepared financially and emotionally stable to handle the responsibility that comes with adopting a kitten
agree to take my cat to the vet if they are sick or to call the rescue ASAP if I do not intend to treat the cat. Cat Tales will have me surrender the cat back to the rescue
